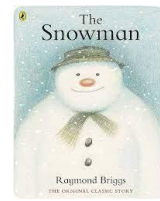
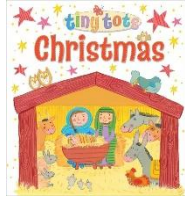
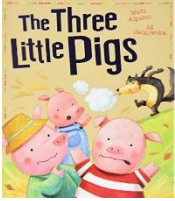


Reception Newsletter - Autumn 2

Welcome back everyone, we hope you had a wonderful week! We have three mini topics this half term which will be Celebrations, Traditional Tales and Seasonal changes. We have already been learning about Bonfire Night and exploring other celebrations that use fireworks. The children have been creating firework pictures. As Winter draws in, we will be learning about Christmas which will include a visit to a local church in December. Singing will be heard as we rehearse our Christmas performance. These are the sounds we will be learning this half term:

- ❖ ff, ll, ss, j
- ❖ v, w, x, y
- ❖ z, zz, qu, ch
- ❖ sh th ng nk
- ❖ words with s /s/ added at the end (hats sits) and words ending s /z/ (his)

We follow the White Rose Scheme of Learning, alongside NCETM Maths Mastery for our Maths Curriculum. Here are the areas covered this term:

- Circles and triangles
- Numbers 4 and 5
- One more, one less
- Compositions of 4 and 5
- Shapes with 4 sides
- Introducing zero
- Comparison of numbers to 5

Reminder: As we promote healthy eating in school; we don't give out birthday treats. We will still celebrate your child's birthday at school 😊

Reminder: Please remember to label all your child's property such as water bottles and coats so they can locate their possessions.

Reminder: Please send your child in wearing comfortable clothing, such as leggings or jogging bottoms and a t-shirt, on Wednesdays (Mr Mentlak) & Thursdays (Mrs Mertens) as we will be having PE sessions.

Reminder: Please return your child's reading book and diary in the plastic wallet provided every Thursday. To keep important letters safe, we will often send them home on Friday in the plastic wallet, please check this regularly.

Reading morning starts Friday 14th November – 8.50-9.20 – all welcome - We will set up the classroom with books but feel free to bring a family favourite. When you arrive find a space, pick a book, and start to read it to your child and whoever else wants to listen. Reading morning will also be on the 21st, 28th of November and the 5th and 12th of December.

Supporting at home

- Visit a Christmas market, note how cold the weather is becoming and how early it gets dark as we transition into winter this term. Comment on how our clothes, food and drink, and family habits change at this time of year. Such as wearing hats and scarfs or enjoying a hot chocolate.
- Read and act out your favourite traditional tales at home. Encourage your child to join in with familiar story language such as “Once upon a time” and “They all lived happily ever after.”
- Visit Greenwich Park, look at the trees that are almost bare of leaves followed by a walk to the market to look at the lights and Christmas decorations.
- Write a Christmas list. Amongst the toys, encourage your child to think of something altruistic they would like such as their friends being happy or everyone being kind to one another.
