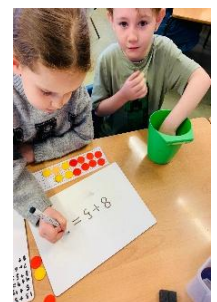

Maths

Mastering Number

In addition to our daily Maths lessons, children have short, discrete fluency sessions that help build children's number sense and automatic recall of number facts.

Home Learning

We have sent the children's Numbots and Times Tables Rock Star logins home. In Year 2 they will be securing their knowledge of the 2, 5, 10, and 3 times tables so please do encourage your children to practise these.



Literacy

We began this half-term writing our own stories featuring Paddington Bear. These were full of funny ideas about the trouble Paddington gets into, but we continue to focus on the accuracy of our writing: editing our own sentences to ensure careful spelling, and the proper use of capital letters and full stops. For the rest of the half-term we will be writing recipes for an amazing school, linked to Anti-Bullying Week (10-15 November), we will spend two weeks linking our writing to the impressionist artist Henri Rousseau and his painting of a tiger in a tropical storm. Alongside this, we will be creating some lovely tiger-themed artwork.

In the build-up to Christmas, our writing centres on some favourite seasonal characters, like the Grinch, Robin Robin and Santa (of course!). We will be writing a character description, a film review, and a Christmas story, respectively.

Reading/Spellings

Up to this point we have been consolidating our phonics knowledge. From this point we are now transitioning to the teaching of spelling; understanding syllables and sound buttons which will help the children spell more accurately. They will be sent home with a list of



'tricky word' spellings every week that will repeat over time so that the children can repeatedly and meaningfully practice them.

We will continue to send children home with a practise book to read which is appropriate to their level. **Please remember to send your children back with their books every Thursday so that we can swap them for home time on Friday.**

In addition to their reading practise book from the classroom, we encourage you to continue reading stories to your child regularly, and have a healthy reading culture at home, to promote the love of reading!

Wider Curriculum

In Science, children will continue to learn all about animals (including humans!). Last week we learned about the needs of a baby. We will go on to explore what makes a balanced diet and why it is important to eat healthy. Later this half-term, we will be learning all about hygiene and why it is important to stay hygienic.

In RE, the children will continue to learn about Hinduism, this time focusing on worship. In Spanish, the children are going to be learning numbers 1-10. In Computing, we will be continuing to focus on coding and will be using Lego Spike.

In Geography, children will be learning about the 7 continents and the 5 oceans. We will also be revisiting their prior Year 1 learning and talking about the country and city in which we live. In PSHE, we are linking this to our upcoming anti-bullying week we will be focusing on positive relationships at school and how we can show respect to others.

PE

This term in PE, we will be honing our ball skills with a focus on basketball. For indoor PE, we will be focussing on our class dance for the upcoming Christmas show. On your child's PE days, please ensure your child is wearing appropriate footwear and clothing for exercise.
