

## Reception Newsletter - Autumn 2

We follow the White Rose Scheme of Learning, alongside NCETM Maths Mastery for our Maths Curriculum. Here are the areas covered this term:

- Representing, comparing and the composition of 1, 2 and 3
- Circles, triangles and spatial awareness
- Numbers to 5
- One more, one less
- Shapes with 4 sides
- ❖ Measurement time
